**Indoor Aquatic Center:** The center has an indoor competition swimming pool and an indoor warm-water recreational/teaching pool with seating and amenities for competitive meets, swim lessons, aquatic programs, water fitness, and recreational swimming. Refer to pool schedule for available times.

**Outdoor Water Adventure:** An outdoor aquatic area provides an outdoor swimming pool, major water slides, grass areas, and concessions. The outdoor aquatic area is equipped with a full-service concession stand with outdoor seating. Refer to pool schedule for available times.

**Teen Center:** A center is provided to give our teens ages 13–18 years old a place of their own. The center includes a game room, computers, video gaming, homework area, and social space.

**Fitness Center:** Equipped with Precor treadmills, ellipticals, bikes, and stair climbers. The center also includes a full weight circuit, cable crossover, and free weights.

**Gymnasium:** Enjoy this double gymnasium with six basketball hoops. This is the perfect space for sports and community events.

**Game Room/Lobby:** The new recreation center has a game room with gaming equipment, seating, and youth space. This is a great space to meet while waiting for swimming or sport practices. This is also a great space for our youth to just have fun in a safe environment.

# Recreation Centers Membership

## Individuals & Family

Membership gives individuals full access to the NGM Recreation Center, swimming pools, and Spring Creek Boys & Girls Club and Recreation Center. Fitness membership also includes free group land/water fitness classes.

**Family** – Married couple and all dependents living at same address. Dependents must be on the parents' tax return.

**Senior** – 60 years old and above.

**Senior Family** – Married couple with the membership carrier being 60 years old and all dependents living at same address. Dependents must be on membership carrier's tax return.

## NGM Recreation Center Babysitting/Nursery

## Corporate Membership Policy


Businesses with ten or more participating employees are eligible for a 10% corporate membership discount.

## Bank Draft

The Boys & Girls Club will automatically draft Recreation Center membership fees from your savings or checking account on the 1st of each month. A 30-day written notice must be given for bank draft membership cancellations.

## Age Requirements

Children 8-12 years old must have an adult 18 years or older in the building or be in a supervised program while at the Recreation Centers. Children 7 years old and younger must be accompanied at all times by a parent/adult or be in the nursery program. Participants must be at least 13 years old to utilize all fitness areas. Supervised programs are open swim, swim lessons, swim team, and nursery.



# Operations & Policies



## Outstanding Balances

Any person with an outstanding balance is not allowed to participate in any Recreation Center or Boys & Girls Club program until the balance is paid. A \$35 fee will be assessed.



## Dress Code

Participants must wear shirts and shoes at all times. Clean, non-marking athletic shoes are required to use the facilities.

All swimmers must wear appropriate swimwear – no jean shorts, thongs, or attire that exposes private parts are permitted.



## Behavior Policy

Individuals that do not follow facility rules will receive a verbal warning on the first offense. The second reprimand will result in the removal from the facility. Alcohol, nicotine pouches, smoking/vaping, and drugs are prohibited on Boys & Girls Club property. Foul language or disruptive behavior is not permitted at the Recreation Centers or Boys & Girls Club. The BGC has the right to refuse service.



## Inclement Weather Policy

In the event of lightning, the indoor and outdoor swimming pools will be closed to ensure the safety of all patrons. During inclement weather, pool facilities may be closed at the discretion of management; however, when conditions allow, open swim may be relocated to the indoor aquatic center.



## Viewing Policy

Immediate Family Members are welcome to observe swim team practices and lessons at no charge. A membership or day pass must be purchased to view open swim and all other programs.



## Locker Policy

Lockers are available for daily use only. Participants must bring their own locks and are required to remove them by the end of each day. Any locks left overnight will be cut and contents removed to maintain locker availability.

A limited number of lockers are available for rent for \$15 per month.



## No Animal Policy

Animals and pets are not allowed inside our facilities. Only service animals, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), are permitted. Under 28 CFR § 35.104, a service animal is a dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for a person with a disability. Please note that emotional support animals, comfort animals, or therapy animals do not qualify as service animals under this law.



## Flotation Devices

Children wearing life jackets or flotation devices must be within arm's reach of a parent or guardian at all times while in the water. Direct supervision is required to ensure the safety of all swimmers using personal flotation devices. Please note that the facility does not provide life jackets or flotation devices.



## Refund Policy

The Boys & Girls Club maintains a no-refund policy for all memberships and program registrations. Unused balance may be applied as credit toward future programs or services.



## Phones/Cameras

Individuals may not take pictures of any members without prior approval.



## Towel Service

Towel service is not provided at the Recreation Centers. All members and guests are responsible for bringing their own towels for swimming, workouts, and showers.



## Music Policy

Members are welcome to listen to personal music using headphones while using the facility. Out of respect for others, music played out loud that may disturb fellow members is not permitted in shared spaces.
