## POLICIES

### *Outstanding Balances*

Any person with an outstanding balance is not allowed to participate in any Boys & Girls Club program until the balance is paid. A \$35 fee will be assessed for checks and drafts returned.

### *Dress Code*

Participants must wear shirts and shoes at all times. Clean, non-marking athletic shoes are required to use Boys & Girls Club facilities.

### *Behavior Policy*

Individuals that do not follow facility rules will receive a verbal warning on the first offense. The second reprimand will result in your removal from the facility. Alcohol and drugs are prohibited on Boys & Girls Club property. Foul language or disruptive behavior is not permitted at the Boys & Girls Club. The Boys & Girls Club has the right to refuse service. Program policies are listed in the Parent Handbook.

### *Admittance Policy*

A camera system is installed to monitor admittance and proper behavior. Any member that violates the rules may lose all membership and program privileges.

### *Age Requirements*

Participants must be at least 12 years old to utilize the fitness center. Children 11 years and younger must be in a supervised program or accompanied by a parent/guardian.

## MEMBERSHIP

### Boys and Girls Club Membership

The Boys and Girls Club is a member organization and requires every individual to become a program member or Recreation Center member to utilize all programs, services, and facilities.

#### Program Member

Program membership gives individuals the privilege to register for any program or service provided by the Boys and Girls Club.

Fee: Individual: \$15 Annually  
Family: \$30 Annually

#### Recreation Center Membership

Recreation Center membership gives individuals access to all Boys and Girls Clubs Recreation Centers. Recreation Center members also receive full program membership privileges as outlined above.
