

Hockey Challenge Volunteers Guide

Your local Knights of Columbus council should provide volunteers for your challenge event. If none are available, volunteer roles may be supplemented by the association's officials and committee leadership.

Challenge volunteers should include:

- 1 - Line Organizer (confirms score sheets are signed, accurate and complete for judge)
- 1- Shooting Judge per Station (tracks points made per contestant)
- 1- Puck Retriever (use foam dividers if desired)
- 1- Challenge Official (tracks scores and presents tiebreakers)

Alternative Options:

2 judges per station, one watching the shot line for infractions, the other tracking goals and points. Both judges help each other confirm accuracy of points gained and organize returned pucks for the next competitor.

Suggestion: Have hockey sticks available to easily pass pucks back and speed up the process.

For best flow, 3 volunteers who can rotate duties per station. At least 1 volunteer organizing the challenger waiting line and confirming completion of the score sheet.

All score sheets must be filled out legibly and accurately before handing it to the shot judge.
