

# 2023 DE MENA WABI SABI

A nose with notes of blueberries, blackberries and spices... Palate: This is Cinsault with substance, a fine wine with great length and an acidulous finish - in a good way!. Great balance for a fluid and fruity wine.



**Vintage:** 2023

**Country:** France

**Region:** Roussillon

**Soil:** Very Stony soils on high terraces.

**Vineyard:** Mont Py

**Grape Varieties:** 100% Cinsault

**Alcohol Content:** 12.5

**Vinification:** 40-60-year-old vines grown on north-facing slopes of stony clays, at 200 meters in the small town of Paziols. The estate is certified organic. The soil is lightly tilled twice a year, and grapes are harvested by hand with small crates. Vinification: maceration of whole bunches for 6 days. Maturation for 7 months in stainless steel tanks. Bottled on the 2nd of April 2024, without fining or filtration, with not even 1 g/hl of sulphur

De Mena [de Mɛnə] is a Catalan term that means "by nature", indeed it is by nature that Sébastien Agelet crafts the beautiful wines of Domaine De Mena. Grape growing has a long tradition in Sébastien's family, his Great Grandfather, Grandfather, and Father have all worked the rugged vineyards around Paziols in the heart of the Pyrenees Mountains. It is with this family tradition in mind, along with a desire to create a legacy of his own that Sébastien decided to pull his family vineyards out of the local co-op and follow his own path, the path of nature, and thus De Mena was born.
