

Chatâeau Franc-Baudron, Montagne St. Emilion



—2012 Franc-Baudron—

Grape Varieties | 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc

Soil | chalky tray on the plateau, clay and limestone on hills on medium and finally deep clay on the bottom of hillsides.

Vineyard | Franc-Baudron

Vinification | Fermented in stainless steel tank and then aged for 1 year in 50% new French oak barrels before being transferred to neutral oak for further aging.

Tasting Notes | Bright and intense in color with aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry, and a hint of cherry and toasty oak notes. The oak is present but fully integrated into the palate allowing the fruit express itself fully. A well-balanced wine, powerful and velvety with lengthy finish.
