Kadarka | Very light in tannin and color, possessing playful, tingling acidity, it is characterized by spiciness and a raspberry-cherry-cranberry note. It can even have a hint of raspberry bubblegum about it.

Average Age of Vines | 10-60 Years

Vineyards | Alsónána, Iván-völgy, & Bencze-völgy

Soil | loess with calcareous 'dolls'

Vinification | Grapes were hand harvested and fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. The wine was aged for 8 months in 75% stainless steel and 25% 600L used Hungarian oak.

Tasting Notes | It is a light bodied wine with gentle tannins. Full of raspberries and cherries on the palate, violets and spices on the nose. It begs to be drunk!



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
