

# 2022 DE MENA WABI SABI

Sébastien Agelet is one of those winemakers who restore the nobility of cinsault, a grape variety rarely used as a single grape variety in cuvées. All the finesse and elegance of this grape variety is revealed in this cuvée whose name evokes in Japanese aesthetics, fullness, modesty or simplicity. In short, only appropriate terms to describe this great wine!



**Vintage:** 2022

**Country:** France

**Region:** Roussillon

**Soil:** Very Stony soils on high terraces.

**Vineyard:** Mont Py

**Grape Varieties:** 100% Cinsault

**Alcohol Content:** 13.5%

**Vinification:** In the cellar, the wines are vinified without any input except a minimal dose of sulphur during bottling. We are looking here for freshness and finesse so that the terroirs reveal themselves in the wines.

De Mena [de Mɛnə] is a Catalan term that means "by nature", indeed it is by nature that Sébastien Agelet crafts the beautiful wines of Domaine De Mena. Grape growing has a long tradition in Sébastien's family, his Great Grandfather, Grandfather, and Father have all worked the rugged vineyards around Paziols in the heart of the Pyrenees Mountains. It is with this family tradition in mind, along with a desire to create a legacy of his own that Sébastien decided to pull his family vineyards out of the local co-op and follow his own path, the path of nature, and thus De Mena was born.

Now only a couple of vintages in De Mena is creating some of the most exciting and talked about natural wines in all of France.
