- Tracking use of force incidents and the importance of “Early Warning Systems”
- How to manage a crisis with the media and the public after a “bad” use of force incident
- The types of disciplinary actions that can be levied against law enforcement officers found to have committed misconduct because of a use of force incident
- Proper procedures for presenting an investigation to the prosecuting attorney in the event a law enforcement officer is suspected of committing a criminal offense relative to a use of force

This program is designed for first-line supervisors, mid-level managers, and police chiefs/sheriffs who have the responsibility to investigate, supervise, and manage use-of-force incidents. This includes both criminal and administrative investigations. The Missouri Police Officer Bill of Rights will be covered in depth.
