- A department-approved 12 gage shotgun, i.e., Remington 870, Mossberg 500, or equivalent, and 20 rounds of 00 Buck ammunition, and 10 rounds of shotgun slugs (as approved by Vista Law Enforcement Training and Consulting, LLC Firearms Instructors (shotgun sling optional if utilized by your individual law enforcement agency)
- A hand-held flashlight (smaller tactical type flashlight preferred) or rail-mounted flashlight
- A baseball-style cap with a bill, wrap-around eye protection, hearing protection (which will not interfere with shoulder shooting of your patrol rifle), and body armor (all mandatory)
- Approved duty handgun with a duty belt and duty holster, double magazine pouch, at least 3 magazines, and 50 rounds of ammunition
- · A patrol rifle, shotgun, and handgun cleaning kit and lubricants
- Attendees must possess the physical strength and stamina to repetitively manipulate and fire their weapons during prolonged drilling, in all weather conditions. The student must be able to get up and down from standing, kneeling, and prone positions, as well as move forward, backward, and laterally
- Attendees need to possess excellent communication skills and the ability to adapt to the role of being a student-learner as well as an instructor. Disruptive or nonproductive attitudes need to be left at home
