- Recognize armorer limitations and when factory or gunsmith service is required
- Understand armorer accountability and risk management tied to duty weapons

## **Course Requirements**

- A copy of your agency's policies and procedures regarding the use of AR-15 style patrol rifles, including storage, maintenance, and patrol rifle minimum training standards for qualification
- .223/5.56 AR-15–style patrol rifle with fixed “iron sights” and optional mounted non-magnified “red dot sights,” both zeroed in before the course, and approved by the agency for on-duty use, subject to inspection and approval by instructors
- Single point or double point sling (no triple point slings), which is applicable to your patrol rifle
- Basic bench armor tools and a bench block for disassembling and reassembling the AR-15 patrol rifle
- 3 AR-15 style .223/5.56 magazines (metal or polymer Magpul style; minimum 30-round capacity), suitable for use with the attendee's rifle, subject to inspection and approval by instructors
- 90 rounds of .223 duty or training ammunition, subject to inspection and approval by instructors (please no 5.56 ammunition)
- Tactical/BDU style clothing with tactical pants pockets, baseball-style cap, wrap-around eye protection, hearing protection (compatible with shoulder-fired weapons), and body armor (Level III +/-Level III A, or higher)
- A complete patrol rifle cleaning kit and proper lubricants
- Sufficient physical strength and stamina to repeatedly manipulate and fire weapons during extended drills in varying weather conditions; attendees must be able to transition between standing, kneeling, and prone positions, and move forward, backward, and laterally
