- Administrating Automated External Defibrillator (AED) through practical exercises
- Proper use of Narcan and demonstration through practical exercises
- Essential items that should be in an officer's medical kit
- Demonstrating the proper way to remove a wounded individual during "Care Under Fire"
- Missouri's Good Samaritan Laws RSMo 195.205, 537.037, and related case laws
- Engage in various role-play scenarios, utilizing all the training methods (Day #2 only)

This course follows the theory of Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC or TC₃) which is the US military guidelines for trauma life support in pre-hospital combat medicine, designed to reduce preventable deaths while maintaining operation success. In TCCC, pre-hospital battlefield care is divided into 3 phases. This course focuses on the first two: Care Under Fire (CUF) and Tactical Field Care (TFC). Other topics regarding first aid and traumatic injury care will also be discussed. <u>Attendees will be certified in First Aid, CPR, and AED</u>.
