- The limitations of confidentially in agency-sponsored Employee Assistance Programs (EAPs) vs. independent, unaffiliated therapists vs. certified peer support groups
- The current advancements in identifying and treating individuals with work-related stress, psychological health issues, and PTSD/PTSI-related traumatic events
- Resources that may be available to individuals both within and outside first responder groups

This course is intended for all first responder personnel and their families. It focuses on the stressors associated with the everyday duties of being a first responder and the physical and psychological struggles during and after a critical incident. It is tailored to assist in recognizing the signs and symptoms associated with stress and psychological issues before they interfere with family life and professional careers.
