- > A handheld tactical flashlight or a rail-mounted weapon light
- > 500 rounds of handgun ammunition, subject to inspection and approval by instructors
- > 120 rounds of .223/5.56 AR-15—style patrol rifle ammunition, subject to inspection and approval by instructors
- > At least 5 training or "dummy" rounds compatible with your handgun
- > Tactical/BDU style clothing with tactical pants pockets, baseball-style cap, wrap-around eye protection, hearing protection (compatible with shoulder-fired weapons), and body armor (Level III +/Level III A, or higher)
- A complete handgun cleaning kit and proper lubricants
- > Sufficient physical strength and stamina to repeatedly manipulate and fire weapons during extended drills in varying weather conditions; attendees must be able to transition between standing, kneeling, and prone positions, and move forward, backward, and laterally
