- -An interpretation of Rule 16. "Abnormal Course Conditions" was distributed with last months minutes.

-Last month's minutes also included recap of Jake's Q & A's with us.

Please disregard what he said under Pace of Play. He cited the OLD RULE for determining your maximin score by hole. As of 1/1/2020 there is a NEW system call **WHS** (World Handicap System)

-There are three types of scores:

-Gross score: all strokes and penalties

-Net score: gross score minus your handicap

- -Adjusted score: Gross score with maximum stroke adjustment made. THIS IS THE SCORE YOU POST IF YOU ARE PROVIDING THE ROUND TOTAL AND NOT POSTING HOLE BY HOLE.
- -THE BEST, EASIEST AND MOST ACCURATE WAY TO POST YOUR SCORE IS HOLE BY HOLE ONN THE GHIN APP. YOU ENTER THE GROSS SCORE (all strokes plus penalties) AND THE SYSTEM DOES ALL THE CALCULATIONS. You do not need to know any calculation rules or formulas.
- One purpose of adjusting score is to improve pace of play. It allows you to pick up and move on when you have just taken 8 shots in the sand on a par 3. There is no point going on so you pick up and enter your most likely score, which is already well over par. If you are posting hole by hole, just put in the estimated likely score e.g. 10.

If you post the whole score you need to make the adjustments to each hold by using the Net Double Bogey System. This requires a working knowledge of the Net Double Bogey System. You do not just include all gross scores with out this adjustment.
