Jake Saito – Official first year as Head Pro. Answering submitted questions from survey.

- **Clinics** – *He loves the Clinics.* He mentioned most all of the Clinics and the importance of each. He is happy for any feedback and if more Clinics are suggested he will consider each one. The \$10.00 paid for each Clinic is donated to Charity. You are playing and paying for a good cause.
 - **Pace of Play** – Jake reviewed **Equitable Stroke Control**. For **9 Holes** if your course handicap is **4** or less your maximum number on any hole is a **(Double Bogey)**; if your handicap is **5 through 9**, maximum number on any hole is **7**; **10 – 14**, maximum number of strokes **8**; **15 through 19**, maximum number **9** and if your course handicap is **20** or more your maximum number **10**. This will increase speed of play. When you reach your maximum number you are to pick up. This applies for regular play. Does not apply for Tournaments. You must putt out on Tournaments.
Be ready to play. Know what club you need, be ready to go to your ball. Do not go to your ball – then back to your cart to get your club. Take a couple of clubs with you. **For those of you driving a cart** – park your cart ahead of your ball, not behind it. You always walk forward to your cart after hitting your ball.
Do not take the time to put your club covers on after hitting your ball. If you can, ride with the club and put the cover on at the next hole.
- **More Tee Times** – Yes you will be given more Tee Times (summer) if you use them.
- **Ladies Derby** – Jake encouraged everyone to join the fun at the Ladies Derby. It will be held on Thursdays and you usually play Holes 1 through 6. It is a hole by hole elimination with a partner. Partners are selected by handicap. High and a low handicap placed together. Larry Sheridan runs the Derby and the cost is \$10.00. You must use a Cart and it is included in the \$10.00 entry fee. Just show up in the Vintage at 5:00 pm, pay your money and have a lot of fun.
- **Golf 101** – Basic Beginners Golf. It is for all levels of membership. It is free, therefore a large turnout usually attends. It is from 12-1:00pm. Call Pro Shop to sign up.
- **Glow Ball** – Will start in March, weather permitting. May have to be postponed until fall due the weather.
- **Fitting Days** – Call the Pro Shop for the dates. Tip – Never adjust your swing to your Club. The Club should be adjusted to fit you.
