  - -Local Rules Marcie would like to take a vote on the winter rule -WINTER RULES (Preferred Lies)

    - -Reference point: Spot of the original ball.
    - -Must not be nearer the hole than where the ball currently lies and you cannot change the cut of grass. For example, moving from the rough to the fairway.
    - -Once placed, the ball is in play and may not be moved again.
  - -Golf Course Maintenance Concerns Discussed
    - -Ball washer on golf course have been found empty without solution/liquid.
    - -Dangerous transition from the 13th fairway to the cart path. Very steep and concerned about carts potentially flipping over.
    - -Tee markers are not wide enough apart and are often facing the wrong direction.
    - -Tuesday's following Monday events the golf course is being left with trash on the course and in bathrooms.

    - -Establishing a first cut of rough at 1.25 inches. Still have many holes to complete. You might see some scalping those area's.
    - -Reduced primary rough cut to 1.75 from 2.0 inches.
