8:30 - 9:00	Breakfast	Students and teachers eat together as a family and learn healthy eating habits. Breakfast provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development.
9:00 - 9:15	Morning Meeting	The teacher will greet the children and sing the morning song, go over job chart, expectations for the classroom, read a story and ask the question of the day.
9:15 - 9:45	Outdoor Play	Activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills.
9:45 - 10:30	Circle	During this time, we will go over the day of the week, the month, the season, and weather descriptions. We will also review letters, phonics, shapes, colors, numbers and counting
10:30 - 11:00	Small/Large Group	The class is split up into one or two groups based on ability, interest, or random selection. Educational games and skills are introduced and practiced. We will also review letter, phonics, shapes, colors, numbers and counting.
11:00 - 12:00	Free Choice	Students decide where they want to go, who they want to play with, and what they want to play with. Our centers are art, blocks, science, library, pretend play, fine motor. New theme activities are added weekly to keep children engaged.
12:00 - 12:30	Lunch	Students and teachers eat together as a family and learn healthy eating habits. Lunch provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development
12:45 - 2:30	Rest Time	When students finish eating, children brush their teeth and lay on their mats for nap time.
2:30 - 3:00	Quiet Activity	For children who wake up before 2:30 choose not to resume their sleep, we offer quiet activities such as kinetic sand, playdough, color/drawing, reading, and scissor practice sheets with kid-safe scissors
3:00 - 3:20	Snack	Students and teachers eat together as a family and learn healthy eating habits. Snack provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development.
3:20 - 3:40	Music & Movement	Language and large muscle development in a group structure.
3:40 - 4:00	End Of Day Meeting	Students go over their sticker charts, sing the goodbye song, talk about their day and their favorite part was.
4:00 - 4:30	Outdoor Play	Activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills.
