

# Hayden Preschool Schedule

7:00 - 8:20	Arrival & Arrival Activities	Students and families are greeted as they arrive. Parents help children put their belongings away, sign into class, pick a job, and choose an arrival activity
8:30- 9:00	Snack	Students and teachers eat together as a family and learn healthy eating habits. Snack provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development. When students finish eating, children brush their teeth.
9:10 - 9:40	Free Exploration	Students decide where they want to go, who they want to play with, and what they want to play. Our centers are art, blocks, science, library, pretend play, fine motor. New theme activities are added weekly to keep children engaged.
9:40 - 10:00	Outdoors	Various gross motor activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills.
10:00 - 10:20	Circle	During this time, we will go over the day of the week', the month, the season, and weather descriptions. We will also review letters, phonics, shapes, colors, numbers and counting
10:20 - 10:40	Small Group	The class is split up into one or two groups based on ability, interest, or random selection. Educational games and skills are introduced and practiced.
10:40 - 11:30	Free Exploration	Students decide where they want to go, who they want to play with, and what they want to play. Our centers are art, blocks, science, library, pretend play, fine motor. New theme activities are added weekly to keep children engaged.
11:30 - 11:45	Outdoors	Various gross motor activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills.
12:00 - 12:30	Lunch	Students and teachers eat together as a family and learn healthy eating habits. Lunch provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development.
12:30-2:30	Nap	
2:30 - 3:00	Quiet Activities	Children help to put mats and bedding away & find quiet table activity to work on
3:00 - 3:20	Snack	Students and teachers eat together as a family and learn healthy eating habits. Snack provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development.
3:20 - 3:40	Music & Movement	Language & large muscle development in a group structure
3:40 - 4:00	Small/Large Group	This is a teacher-led art project that usually involves getting messy. Activities often include process art, name recognition crafts, primary color exploration, and seasonal crafts.
4:00 - 4:30	Outdoors	Outdoor or indoor exploration.
4:30 - 5:30	Departures	Children clean up, inform their parents about their day, check their cubby for take home items and belongings, sign out, and say good-bye
