

Hayden Toddler Daily Schedule

7:00 - 8:00	Arrival & Arrival Activities	Toddler Students and families are greeted as they arrive in the Preschool/Toddler room. Parents help children put their belongings away, Students decide what activities they would like to play in the areas that the teachers have available.
8:30 - 9:00	Snack	Students wash their hands and eat together as a family. Morning snack provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development. Children wash their hands after eating and go to the circle to read books.
9:00 - 9:15	Circle /Music & Movement	The circle begins with a music & movement activity. Once the children are settled, the group works on calendar concepts, weather, the letter, color, and shape of the week. Circle ends with a story or flannel board story.
9:15	Diaper Changes / Potty Training	
9:15 - 10:45	Free Play at Stations	The teacher will set up "stations" in the learning areas for the children to choose from. Often these stations will include manipulatives, blocks, language/literature, science/sensory table, dramatic play, gross motor play, and self-led art.
10:45 - 11:30	Outdoor Activity/Walk	Activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills. May also take walks around the neighborhood/to the park (weather permitting)
11:30 - 11:45	Story Time	The teacher will read a story to entire group
11:30	Diaper Changes / Potty Training	
11:45 - 12:15	Lunch	Students wash their hands and eat together as a family. Lunch provides many opportunities to explore math concepts, fine motor skills and language development. Children wash their hands after eating and go to their mats for rest time.
12:15 - 1:30/2:30	Rest Time	
As children awake	Diapering/Potty Breaks	
1:30 - 2:30	Quiet Activity	For children who wake up before 2:30 and choose to not resume their sleep, we offer quiet table activities such as kinetic sand, playdough, color/drawing, reading, and scissor practice.
2:30 - 3:00	Circle Time	Music & Movement & Story. Wash hands and go to table for afternoon snack.
3:00 - 3:30	Snack	Students eat together as a family. Afternoon snacks provide many opportunities to explore healthy food, math concepts, fine motor skills and language development. When students finish eating, they brush their teeth together with guidance from teachers.
3:30 - 4:15	Free Play	The teacher will set up "stations" in the learning areas for the children to choose from. Often these stations will include manipulatives, blocks, language/literature, science/sensory table, dramatic play, gross motor play, and self-led art.
3:45 - 4:00	Diapering/Potty Breaks/Wash Hands	
4:00 - 5:30	Outside Time Go Home	Activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills.
