- 1. Highlights/Ministry Dashboard-Ryan

19:00 Business in Process/Updates

- 1. Legacy Dinner- Our first annual Legacy Dinner is 11/15. It is simply a night to thank people who have given and will feature 7 small testimonies of how giving is impacting lives. A donor is covering ½ the cost of dinner. We are anticipating 80 people from the list of those who have given \$1000 or more in 2024.
- 2. Legacy Offering- We have transitioned from Faith Promise in early spring to Legacy Offering in late fall. We accidently didn't schedule Faith Promise before sabbatical and Pastor Ryan had already been wanting to move to a name change and season change. The Legacy Offering will cover 4 Legacy Lanes: City First Projects, City First Next Gen, Local Projects, and Global Projects. For City First Next Gen, Pastor Ryan has a dream of a \$1,000,000 endowment fund for CFCA scholarships. The more practical goal is raising \$5000 for direct scholarship fund for school to manage.

- 3. Hwy 99 IDEA- DS Brett said he would look at a proposal for district support of planting a church for the unhoused. Kimber feels called to this ministry. We need to build a team and find funding and property (Porky's Palace is an idea). Dennis mentioned that some people might wonder why we would plant something so close to Fairfield. Ryan answered that this church would be targeted at the unhoused, so would offer no real "competition" for Fairfield congregation.
- 4. Second Service Combo with Awakening Church IDEA- Awakening Church led by Pastor Clint is looking for a new place to worship beginning in January. We have offered them the Downtown campus at 3:30 pm on Sundays. Ryan talked to Clint about the idea of a combo service at 11 am. This idea needs time for prayer, conversation and thought.
- Tech Director- We continue to look for someone to fill our non-paid Tech Director position. Pastor Daniel's friend, Trace Bailey, is interested. He will be visiting this weekend with his wife and daughter. They have been interested in moving to the PNW for some time.
