

Bergamot Essential Oil (Bergaptene Free)

Botanical Name: Citrus bergamia

Plant Part: Crude Fruit Peel

Extraction Method: Cold Pressed

Color: Light yellowish green to yellowish brown liquid.

Common Uses

In this variety, the bergaptene content which causes photosensitivity has been removed. This allows the Bergamot to be used in skin and hair care formulations without worrying about sun exposure after use. Bergamot Bergaptene Free Essential Oil can be used to treat skin ailments such as psoriasis and eczema and it is considered to relieve stress and anxiety.

Cautions

May cause skin irritation in some individuals; a skin test is recommended prior to use. Contact with eyes should be avoided. Avoid use during pregnancy. Contraindications: Do not use in cases of liver problems. Not for use when pregnant or nursing.
