Botanical Name: *Melaleuca alternifolia*

Plant Part: Leaves

Aromatic Scent: Tea Tree Oil is terpenic, medicinal, fresh, woody, earthy, & herbaceous.

Blends With: Bergamot, Black Pepper, Chamomile, Cinnamon, Clary Sage, Clove, Cypress, Elemi, Eucalyptus, Fir (Siberian), Geranium, Ginger, Lavandin, Lavender, Lemon, Mandarin, Marjoram, Nutmeg, Oakmoss, Orange (sweet), Palmarosa, Peppermint, Ravensara, Rosemary, Tangerine, Thyme.

Common Uses:

Antibacterial, antiviral, antifungal, expectorant, and insecticide. Used for Acne, athlete's foot, candida, chicken pox, cold sores, colds, corns, cuts, flu, insect bites, itching, migraine, oily skin, ringworm, sinusitis, sores, spots, urethritis, warts, whooping cough.

Cautions:

Tisserand and Young indicate that there is a low risk of skin sensitization when using Tea Tree topically. They recommend a dermal maximum of 15% and precaution to avoid use of the oil if it has oxidized.

Never ingest or use an essential oil undiluted unless advised by your health care provider or certified aromatherapist. Keep essential oils away from infants, children, and all pets.
