A Miracle in Motion: How One Family Found Hope – Thanks to You

At the Beaverton Resource Center, our days are often filled with urgency, complexity, and quiet moments of grace. Though we are not a faith-based organization, many of our leaders walk in faith—and every so often, something happens that feels like a gentle reminder from the universe: "You're on the right path."

This is one of those moments.

Recently, we were introduced to a courageous single mother with a spinal cancer diagnosis. Her illness has forced her to stop working. Without income, she was evicted from her apartment and began living in her car with her three young children, all of whom attend school in the Beaverton School District.

Shelters across Washington County are full. Housing assistance takes time. This Mom has no family network to lean on. She is in pain and struggling, but she is still showing up for her children. And our community has been showing up for her.

Thanks to a teacher, a church, and a family who knows the struggle of housing instability, we were able to place this family in a hotel for several nights. When our emergency funds ran out, we turned to the community for help.

And help arrived.

One of our own volunteers saw the story on Facebook. She and her husband had just learned their rental condo was vacant—and without hesitation, they offered it to this mother and her children, free of charge, for two weeks.

This is the spirit of the Beaverton Resource Center. This is the power of a community that cares.

This mother's journey is far from over. She still needs long-term housing and ongoing support. But today, she and her children are safe. Today, they have a roof. And today, we have you, our village of compassionate, action-driven neighbors.

You can still help.

We are continuing to raise funds to provide a bridge to shelter and support for this parent and her children until a long-term solution is in place.
