- You continue to provide your patient's ongoing primary care.
- A procedure summary and recommendations are sent back to you after the procedure.
- Patients are returned to the referring GP for ongoing contraceptive and general health care.

Not suitable for referral:

- Deep, impalpable or difficult Implanon removal
- Previous failed insertion
- Significant cervical stenosis
- Suspected uterine anomaly or cavity-distorting fibroids
- Anticipated need for sedation
- Other significant complexity
