General Guidelines

- Learners must be clean, neat, and modestly dressed.
- All clothing must be non-distracting, comfortable, and appropriate.
- ACA learners are expected to wear **solid-colored tops and bottoms** in ACA colors: red, gray, black, or white.



Tops

- **Solid-colored** shirts in red, gray, black, or white (long or short sleeves).
- ACA-branded t-shirts, polos, or sweatshirts are encouraged.
- No patterns, graphics, or logos other than ACA.
- Shoulders must be covered; no spaghetti straps, tank tops, or crop tops.



Bottoms

- **Solid-colored** pants, jeans, leggings, or modest-length shorts/skirts in red, gray, black, white or khaki.
- Skirts/shorts must be mid-thigh or longer when standing.
- Rips or holes must be appropriate and may not expose skin; no open holes above the knee are allowed.
- Clothing must not be excessively tight or form-fitting.



Outerwear

- Jackets, sweaters, and hoodies worn indoors must be in school colors.
- Hoods may not be worn over the head inside the building.



Shoes

- Closed-toe shoes are required for safety and activity.
- Sneakers or supportive shoes are preferred for daily movement-based learning.
- No flip-flops, sandals, slides, or high heels. Croc's only allowed on Friday's.



Spirit Days

- Special ACA t-shirts may be worn with jeans or ACA color bottoms.
- Themed dress days will be announced in advance.
