**Daniel** had three friends named **Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.**They trusted God above all else – even if it might get them in trouble.
Things go really hot but God protected them. God even sent someone to be with them so they were not alone. You can read about the story in Daniel 3. How hard is it for you to do something scary or dangerous?
