Come, now is the time to worship!

An interesting discussion came up at our latest Council meeting about the need for and meaning of worship — and even how it is perceived by others. Precipitated by the departure of Paula, Greg, and Dean from weekly music leadership, our pattern for worship on Wednesdays is undergoing a shift in format. Some may wonder if it is indeed worship — since it may not follow forms we may be familiar with or use .

Generally, <u>WORSHIP</u> is understood to be "the feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a deity; or 2 show reverence and adoration for a deity; honor with religious rites." CHRISTIAN Worship is giving homage, thanks and praise to the God reveal through the Scriptures, who is still active in the world around us, and to the incarnate Jesus Christ.

LUTHERAN Worship goes further — centering the worship pattern in a four-fold movement of Gathering (the Holy Spirit calls us together as the people of God) Word (God speaks to us in scripture, preaching and song) Meal (God feeds us with the presence of Christ) Sending (God blesses us and sends us in mission to the world.)

Notice in every movement the primary actor is God — and we receive the grace God offers so we can share it with others. We expect it to change our hearts and engage our lives.

All are welcome at every service – whether Traditional; Campfire, Festival, Cup of Blessing, Longest Night, Taize, Evening Prayer, Prayer Around the Cross, Lectio Divina, Silent Meditation, Healing, Hymn Sing, Matins, Compline, Camp style, Rogation, or Candlelight. This Fall, we will be learning some of these different ways of worshipping together on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-7:00. Youth will help lead these services as they grow familiar with them. Some will include music, some may not. And that is OK. We move in this world in different ways, yet we are called to serve all people- even each other with the grace, consolation and forbearance of God's love.




