

The Theory of God's Fruit...Reassembled

Hypothesis: Without manipulating any genetic material, man can hybridize various tree-fruits of this world in order to reestablish a society in which it is possible to receive all necessary daily nutrition by eating some amount of three different fruits: single seed fruit (pepri), small-group fruit (cholaris), and multi-seed fruit (poco). While this process shall take as little as 700 years to complete, as each hybridized generation must grow to at least 20 years of age before harvesting the seed to begin a new generation; by eating this fruit exclusively, man can once again live to be over 400 years old.

Method:

1. Focus on proving the possibility: I will begin my experiment by testing the hypothesis on Single Seed Fruit and Small-Group Fruit as they are more readily available within the United States of America. If I can achieve successful combination of both types of fruit through generation one, I will commence with multi-seed fruit.
2. Selecting the Fruit: I will locate two apple farms in Washington State, two plum farms from an indigenous region of the plum, two peach farms in Georgia, and two pear farms in New Hampshire. I will travel to each farm and select 10 fruits from their best two trees; then evaluate each fruit for quality of skin, total mass and nutritional content. After evaluation I will choose the best two seeds and germinate them.
3. Germination of the seeds: *This will be developed after my study of biochemistry.*
4. Preparation of the soil: Through the harvesting of seeds from grain, fruits and vegetables you can create the foundation for a proper diet. Not to be ingested like a pill that gets processed through the body in a matter of seconds, but used as the foundation for a radical new way of farming. All the various seed, after being ground to the point where they cannot be germinated, when combined with actual rocks containing necessary

minerals and shaved metals like zinc and iron plus an ample amount of ash and sewage water will create a soil highly concentrated with all necessary dietary compliments and supplements. During the process of photosynthesis nutrients are suckled from the ground by drawing in water. That is to say, the higher an existing concentration of nutrients in the soil the higher concentration of nutrients will exist in the water. More in the water means more in the plant-life which becomes our best source of food. You see the human body is not designed to ingest and process meat unless absolutely necessary and it is no longer necessary. Protein is found in a variety of nuts and the seeds of any fruit or vegetable. With the reutilization of the seeds of the first crop in the second the nutritional value will increase, perhaps doubling every time. By utilizing the natural minerals and nutrients found in the earth we will also bring out the natural healing abilities in the body and stimulate areas of the uncharted human brain. I also hold it to be true that this process will steadily speed up photosynthesis thereby producing a more natural quality of oxygen; actually combating pollution.

5. Production of generation one: I will grow each of the eight trees until they are a yew tree of three meters tall; that is to say it is a fruit tree which has blossomed, but not yet born fruit.

While human history may call me a fool for believing this, the term yew tree actually stems from Genesis. You see when Hagar (the mother of Ishmael) was bestow with the knowledge of the bow, she was not only instituted with the knowledge of how to use a bow and arrow but how to make them. Furthermore, I find that when she came upon the yew tree she eat of the leaf and flower, chewing them until they were but fibers. She then rolled the fiber to create the yew of the bow. The bow itself the either made from the largest branch or, more likely, the tree itself.
