- 1. Parents should support the efforts of the volunteer coaches and the league. And always set an example by showing good sportsmanship.
- 2. The use of profanity, drugs, alcohol, tobacco products as well as e-cigarettes, and vaping products on school property is prohibited. (It is an illegal act) This will result in your immediate ejection from school property.
- 3. Never argue with an official or coach during practice or games. Any complaint or concern can be made in writing, first to the head coach, then to the LSJAA Cheer Board of Directors if needed. All complaints will be promptly investigated.
- 4. Understand that your child will be given every opportunity to participate and to compete, however the safety of our athletes is our number one concern.
- 5. Any parent who enters the playing field during a game (except for an injury to your child) risks their or their child's immediate removal from the field and/or disqualification from further participation. This rule shall be enforced by the game's officials, team coaches and/or LSJAA Cheer Board Member.
- 6. Any parent who incurs an unsportsmanlike behavior penalty, in accordance with WIAA rules, during a game risks their child's immediate removal from the field and/or disqualification from further participation. This rule shall be enforced by the game's officials, team coaches and/or LSJAA Cheer Board Member.
- 7. Try to praise your child's efforts and always offer your support as well as allowing your child to have fun and play as a child.
- 8. Never voice any complaints or concerns towards coaches, referees, or league officials in front of the players. Show proper respect of an official, coaches or referees judgement. If an issue is had please direct it to the coach away from players.
- 9. Parents shall respect the equipment given to their child and take care of it. Parents shall be responsible to pay to replace equipment that is lost or damaged by alteration or neglect.
- 10. Parents shall support the fundraising efforts of their child's coach. If questions are had in regards to fundraising, please set a time to talk with your coach in regards to this. Please do so away from players.
- 11. Parent's shall inform the coach personally, or provide written permission for their child to walk, ride bike, etc. to be picked up by someone other than the parent.
- 12. Parents shall understand that Social Media is not a place to speak badly of coaches or the league. As well as understanding the same goes for their athlete.
