Autism Spectrum Disorder, or ASD, is a developmental disability that causes profound Communication, Social, and Behavioural Challenges.

ASD is an "Umbrella Term" for a variety of conditions including:

- Asperger's Syndrome
- Pervasive Developmental Disorder
- Autistic Disorder

Signs and Symptoms of ASD may include (not limited to):

- Repetitive/Rapid movements. These are called "Stims"
- Struggle to understand and Communicate Feelings
- Struggle with Physical Contact, and Eye Contact
