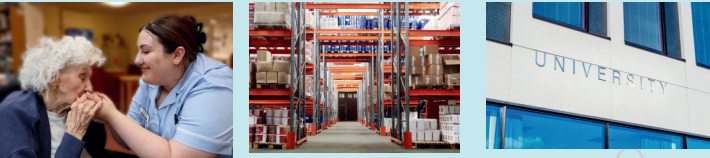
Looking for Work?
