

Twenty-Eighth Congress of the Republic of Texas

Proposed Resolution for an amendment to Article III Section 2 of the Constitution

Sec. 1. Be it resolved by the senate and the house of representatives of the republic of Texas in Congress assembled, under the Declaration of Emergency for the protection of the people of Texas, the following amendment be enacted within the election process due to threats imposed by an invasion of unlawful immigrants crossing the borders of the republic of Texas, the presence of domestic terrorists operating within the republic of Texas government that interfered with the 2023 election that disenfranchised Texians of their right to vote in the 2023 election, the theft of the republic of Texas website and other media applications and a coup to overthrow the government of the republic of Texas.

Sec. 2. Be it further resolved to achieve protection for the Texian people who are domiciled on the lands of the republic of Texas that the following actions be taken under this Declaration of Emergency of amending the constitution of the republic of Texas with the objective of this amendment being to promote stability in the republic of Texas government by increasing the amount of time a president has to accomplish tasks that need to be completed.

Sec. 3. Be it further resolved, as is currently written in the Constitution; Article III Section 2. *The first president elected by the people shall hold his office for the term of two years, and shall be ineligible during the next succeeding term; and all subsequent presidents shall be elected for three years, and be alike ineligible; and in the event of a tie, the house of representatives shall determine between the two highest candidates by a viva-voce vote.*

Sec. 4. Be it further resolved the following amendment be enacted, Article III Section 2 of the Constitution to read as follows:
The first president elected by the people shall hold his office for the term of two years, and shall be ineligible during the next succeeding term; and all subsequent presidents shall be elected for *three* years, and shall be *eligible to serve no more than two consecutive terms*; and in the event of a tie, the house of representatives shall determine between the two highest candidates by a viva-voce vote.
