

Twenty-Eighth Congress of the Republic of Texas

Proposed Resolution for an amendment to Article 1 Section 5 of the Constitution

Sec. 1. Be it resolved by the senate and the house of representatives of the republic of Texas in Congress assembled, under the Declaration of Emergency for the protection of the people of Texas, the following amendment be enacted within the election process due to threats imposed by an invasion of unlawful immigrants crossing the borders of the republic of Texas, the presence of domestic terrorists operating within the republic of Texas government that interfered with the 2023 election that disenfranchised Texians of their right to vote in the 2023 election, the theft of the republic of Texas website and other media applications and a coup to overthrow the government of the republic of Texas.

Sec. 2. Be it further resolved to achieve protection for the Texian people who are domiciled on the lands of the republic of Texas that the following actions be taken under this Declaration of Emergency of amending the Constitution of the republic of Texas with the objective of this amendment being to promote stability in the government by allowing the congress to function within the confines of the Constitution.

Sec. 3. Be it further resolved, as is currently written in the Constitution in Article 1 Section 5, the house of representatives shall not consist of less than twenty-four, nor more than forty members, until the population shall amount to one hundred thousand souls, after which time the whole number of representatives shall not be less than forty, nor more than one hundred: Provided, however, that each county shall be entitled to at least one representative.

Sec. 4. Be it further resolved that the following amendment be enacted, Article 1 Section 5 of the Constitution to read as follows:

The house of representatives shall not consist of less than twenty-four, nor more than forty members, until the population shall amount to one hundred thousand souls, after which time the whole number of representatives shall not be less than forty, nor more than one hundred provided, however, **“until” each county is represented, the house of representatives is authorized to conduct business**, and that each county shall be entitled to at least one representative.
