HOW TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR LIMITED TEXIAN ID CARD

With your ID CARD APPLICATION you must also send a digital image of yourself to: adamkranston@pm.me . A phone image is acceptable if you don't have a digital camera. The image should be a quality head shot, similar to a passport photo. Use a plain, light colored background. No hats, caps or glasses. This will be the image that will appear on your card for the next 5 years. It's okay to smile!

There is a charge of \$75.00 (\$85.00 if outside the united States) for the ID card to cover the costs incurred. If sending a check or money order, make payable to: SOS Kenneth Barnett. The ID card is valid for 5 years. If your card must be replaced during that time there is a cost of \$40.00 for a replacement card. We have Congressional sessions once a month, the location, date and time are shown on the home page of this website. You can attend these meetings if you wish, to learn more about how and why the government exists and operates. If you come to one of these meetings you may also pay for your ID card with three oz of silver instead of \$70.00 (three and one half oz if outside the united States). I wouldn't recommend mailing silver, but it has been done, and you can. We also accept federal reserve notes.
