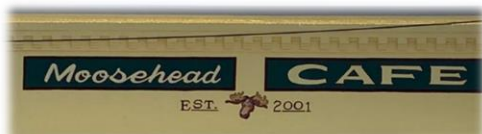

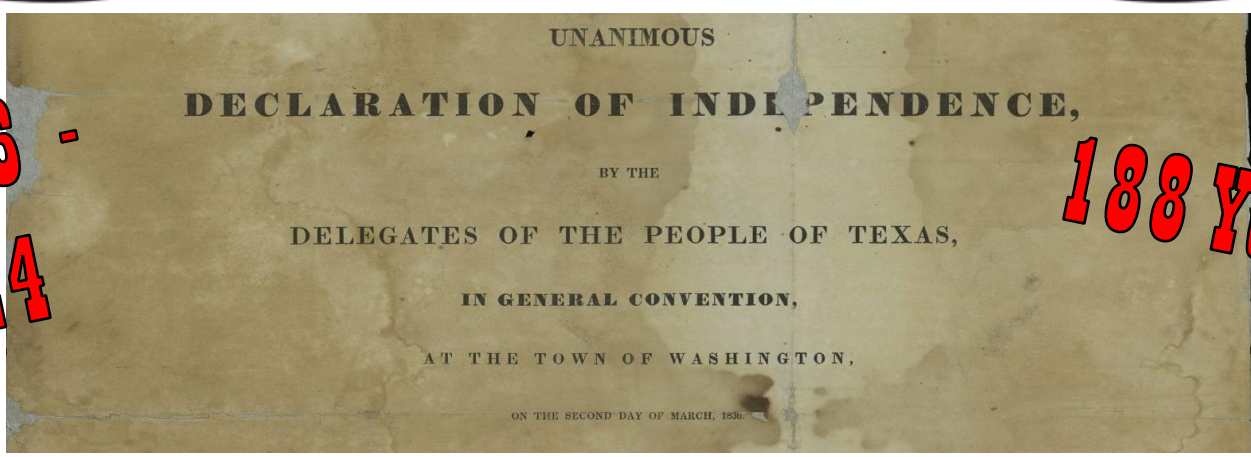

# Crockett, Texas EST 1837



The town was incorporated on December 29, 1837, and a post office opened there on March 31, 1838. The town was named after David Crockett, who is said to have camped at a nearby spring in 1836 after leaving Nacogdoches after he had signed to join the Texian Army on January 14, 1836. He was on his way to Washington on the Brazos where he arrived January 23, 1836
