<u>Applicant Presentation:</u> Ms. Ahmann was present to address questions. She explained that the proposed site, an enclosed garage, has been utilized as a private art studio. She is requesting to offer classes to not more that three students at a time. The proposed hours of operation are 1:00 p.m. -5:00 p.m.

Ms. Ahmann explained the layout of the garage which is divided into two sections. One area is dedicated to pottery and the other side is designated to canvass painting.

Board Member Harriman asked various questions relating to the potential impact to the neighborhood. Questions from Board member Harriman included the impact to parking, number of available exits, whether paints/chemicals are stored at the proposed site.

Ms. Ahmann explained that there are 3 exits and she stores non-toxic paints, etc. She retains a fire extinguisher on site and feels parking should not be an issue.
