New Business

Discussion and/or action to consider grant applications for recommendation and approval from the Clifton Town Council:

A. Removal of asbestos from town buildings – Funding Arizona Department of Environmental Quality: Town Manager Rudy Perez reported that prior to a lease commitment between the town and United Way to utilize the property, a site assessment would be appropriate to assure a safe environment. He further reported that he had arranged an onsite meeting with a representative from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality to determine potential grant funding opportunities. He explained that if awarded, the Brownfields State Response Grant would provide an assessment of potential contaminants of concern, such as asbestos and/or lead-based paint. If it is determined that the building does contain these contaminates, the town could pursue to abate the material as the next phase.
