HOW TO FILE ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST PROPOSITION NO. 400
the Alternative Expenditure Limitation (Home Rule Option)

WHEN TO FILE

File written arguments with the Town Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m., May 4, 2022. Arguments will be included in the Town of Clifton sample ballot/publicity pamphlet prepared for the election. The pamphlet will be mailed to each household with a qualified elector of the Town of Clifton.

CONTENTS OF ARGUMENT

1. Argument shall not exceed 300 words (inclusive of name(s) and title(s) of sponsor(s).
2. Each argument must be submitted to the Town Clerk in electronic format and emailed to castaneda@townofclifton.com or hello@townofclifton.com
3. Argument must be clearly identified at the top of the page as either:
"ARGUMENT FOR PROPOSITION 400" **OR** "ARGUMENT AGAINST PROPOSITION 400"
4. Arguments filed for inclusion in the publicity pamphlet must include a sworn statement from the person, organization or political action committee submitting the argument.
Suggested verbiage: I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing information is true and correct and I am the sponsor of this argument advocating or opposing this measure, question or proposition.
5. Argument shall contain the original signature of each person sponsoring it. If an organization sponsors an argument, it shall be signed by two executive officers thereof. If a political committee sponsors the argument, it shall be signed by the committee's chairperson or treasurer. All signers shall identify themselves by printing their name, residence or post office address and a telephone number. Address and telephone numbers will NOT be printed in the Town's sample ballot/publicity pamphlet except that the person's town and state of residence shall appear in the pamphlet.

Any argument that is submitted that does not comply with these requirements may not be included in the pamphlet.
