

How-to Access Your 2022 Statement



Procare provides Year-End Statements that can be accessed by parents for child care reimbursements or tax purposes.

You can pull your year-end tax statements in your parent portal.



Statements include:

- Name & Address of our program
- Time Period of the statement
- Tax ID
- Names of the Parents on the Account
- Previous Balance from any time before the start date
- All transactions through the period specified
- Ending balance at the end of the period specified









 Please understand that transition times, especially during drop-off and pick-up, we must remind you that best practice is do it as quickly as possible. Many of our babies are at various stages of stranger anxiety. It eases the envrionment for all babies and

staff when we are able to create a safe place for those that have a harder time. We will always communicate via the ProCare app if there are any issues. If you have any questions don't hesitate to speak with Mr. Josiah or Miss Cary about your concerns.

- We have been in the process of a couple of grants.
 - Montgomery Village was awarded a yard grant (March 2022) that has yet to be funded.
 However, progress seems to be heading our way. Unfortuantely, prices have increased since the award which means some items may no longer be included. We remain hopeful that we will be able to complete most of that project.
 - Our Humboldt center has submitted for a grant (January 2023). We are hopeful our project will be selected. We will are hoping to update lighting and divide the larger playroom into two spaces. This will allow us to separate age groups for a more conducive setting. Our plan is to have a space for 'under 12 months', '12-18 months' and the side room will be '18-24 months'.
- Please remember that although we are no longer under strict COVID guidelines, Santa Rosa Rise and Shine still practices many of those guidelines.
 - No items back and forth from home except what arrives on first day of attendance and returns on the last day (bottles are an exception).
 - Please include a wet bag or extra plastic bag for soiled clothing.
