▲ Important Program Funding Update for 2026

Rise and Shine would like to share an important update regarding our funding structure for the upcoming year.

After much consideration, and due to circumstances outside of our control, we have made the difficult but necessary decision to voluntarily release our State CCTR contract effective December 31, 2025. This means that beginning January 1, 2026, Rise and Shine will no longer provide in-house subsidized care through the CCTR program.

We want to reassure all families that: Our program operations, quality of care, curriculum, and staffing will not change. We will continue offering the same high-quality, relationship-based infant care you know and trust.

Families will still be able to enroll using:

- ✓ Private pay
- √ 4Cs
- √ SonomaWORKS / CalWORKs
- ✓ River to Coast, Child Family Circle, and other third-party funding sources

For families currently receiving CCTR support, this change will require securing an alternate form of assistance or moving to private pay beginning January 2026. We are committed to helping families with this transition and will provide the Notice of Action documentation needed for continuity-of-care considerations.

We understand that this update may bring concern, and we deeply appreciate the understanding, trust, and partnership of all our Rise and Shine families. This decision—while incredibly difficult—was necessary to ensure the long-term sustainability and stability of our program.

As always, our mission remains the same: to provide safe, nurturing, and developmentally enriching care for Sonoma County's youngest learners.
