

ERNATIONAL INDOOR CUP INTERNATIONAL INDOOR 2025

REGULATION

THIS REGULATION IS APPLICABLE TO ALL CATEGORIES EXCEPT FOR SOME SUBPARAGRAPHS

1. PLAYER REGISTRATION: All players must be registered on their teams' registration form before they play any match. Any team or player determined by the event director to have falsified name, age, or skill level will be kicked out of the tournament.

All players must carry proof of identification, i.e. driver's license, passport, etc. The document must be original and must have the player's name, date of birth, and a recent photo.

The team must present proof of identification immediately upon request by tournament officials.

2. NUMBER OF PLAYERS: In all categories each team may register unlimited players. In case the band falls off the player will have to bring his band and his ID and \$20.00 per band. All players must have their armband on before entering the sports complex.

3. PLAYER LIST: All starting rosters must be submitted by 9:00 PM on Friday night. The limit to increase players will be PRIOR to their SECOND group stage game on Saturday. The tournament will provide each player with one bracelet per day, which players must wear at all times. A player who has not participated in any group stage games will be able to play in the playoffs as long as he is registered on the official list. A player can only play on one team in the tournament (even if it is in a different division).

To. To participate in the tournament all players must be duly registered. In case a player participates in the tournament with a team and is not registered, he will lose the game with a score of 3-0 against



B. Any coach who wishes to participate as a player with his team must be registered on the list as a player, otherwise the team will lose the game by a score of 3-0.

4. EQUIPMENT: All players must wear shin guards and may not use anything that is considered dangerous to the referee or tournament officials. The ball will be #5

5a. UNIFORMS: All teams must have at least two different sets of uniforms (different colors). In case they do not have them, the team that is on the right side of the key will be forced to turn the shirt inside out or look for an alternative uniform.

5. REFEREE FEE: Each team must pay all group game referees at check-in (\$120 per game. At that time, the team will receive an official copy of the game list form that will be completed by the team and given to the referee before the game starts.

7. GAME DURATION: The duration of the game will be 30 minutes in the group stage. Group stage games, if they can end in a draw. Playoff games (direct elimination) will be played in 30 rows and cannot end in a tie. The game will go straight to penalties if there is a tie at the end of regular time (3 penalties).

8. Players will pay \$20.00 per day and must wear the armband before entering the sports complex.

9. POINTS (IN GROUP STAGE):

3 points for winning;

1 point for a draw and

0 points for defeat.

A team forfeit is scored as a 3-0 win. A team must be present in order to win by forfeit and at least 7 players.



10. TIEBREAKS: In THE GROUP STAGE, ties between two or more teams will be broken as follows:

A) points;

B) goal difference in group games;

- C) the majority of goals scored in pool games;
- D) Results between direct duels;
- E) Red cards
- F) Yellow Cards
- G) Coin draw for teams already qualified
- H) Penalty kicks if it is to determine who qualifies (exemplified 16 and 17).

11. PLAYER EXPULSION (RED CARD): Referees have the right to expel a player from the game for continued disobedience or as a result of an incident that warrants the player's expulsion. Tournament directors can ban the player for the remainder of the tournament or suspend one or more games. The team that received a red card (or two yellows in the same game) will have to pay a \$100 fine and this fine will have to be paid before the next game. The player will be able to play in the next game if tournament officials determine that the red card was not serious.

12. SPORTSMANSHIP: Players, coaches and spectators are expected to act in the nature of good sportsmanship at all times. Abuse of referees will not be tolerated. Any instance of such conduct by a player the team will lose the game by a difference of 3-0. Penalty shootout: Any person who is observed (player or any member of the coaching staff or fan) throwing balls towards where the penalty taker is will be expelled from the complex.

13. A: In the event that the referee is violently assaulted by a player, coach, manager, president, kit man of X team and within the game there was already a difference in score (GOAL), the team will be removed from the game giving the winner to the rival team of the



offender and will result in the difference in the game. If the match persists in a tie or the team that committed the foul is losing at the time of the aggression, 2 goals difference A WINNING SCORE will be awarded to the team that did not commit the foul.

B: If a match is suspended due to a mutual quarrel between both teams and there has already been a difference in score (goal) in favor of

one, will be the winner of the match, in case there is a tie the decision will be made by the organizing committee of

C: If doubts persist for such a decision, evidentiary means (videos) could be required...

14. PROTEST: A team can protest a game. The protest form will be available at the tournament and must be completed. The cost of protesting a game will be \$250 and is only done with the tournament officials and will have to be done no later than 5 minutes after receiving the referee's report. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE DECISIONS OF AN ARBITRATOR ARE IRREVOCABLE.

15. Substitutions: There will be free substitutions, which means that a team can have an unlimited number of substitutions during the game and a player who was substituted CAN return to the game.

16. Prizes: PREMIER CATEGORY: The two finalists will receive a team trophy, as well as 20 medals. In addition, second place and champions will receive a combined \$15k. \$12k for the champion and \$3k for second place.

CATEGORY C: The two finalists will receive a team trophy, as well as 20 medals. In addition, second place and champions will receive \$8k combined. \$6k for the B champion and \$2K for second place.



17. At check-in, each team must submit their roster form completely filled out.

Players do not need to be present.

18. Each player will receive a wristband at check-in (received by the coach).

This bracelet must be worn by each player at all times.

19. On the bench, only registered players and 3 (THREE) coaches or assistants plus the kit man and the masseur can be on the bench.

20. There will be no overtime to start the game, except for the opening games on Saturday and Sunday as long as they do not exceed 10 minutes, for games during the day the teams will have a maximum wait of 10 minutes. All games must start on time. The referee may start the time of the match if one of the two teams is on the field and they are not ready to start the match. There will be no bowling of the game except in the finals. During the tournament the clock will start on time and if a team has already

is on the field and his opponent does not show up for 5 minutes will receive a goal against until 10 minutes and the

The game will be terminated with a score of 3-0.

21. Each team must be ready at least 10 minutes before play on the field to be checked by the referees or tournament officials. Teams must be ready with an official roster copy, which will be given once they pay the referee fee at the board of directors.

22. A team may be disqualified if, in the opinion of the referee or tournament officials, the team does not make the best effort to win a match. This happens more when two teams need a result in the last group game to advance. NOTE: IF A TEAM LEAVES AT HALFTIME OF THEIR GAME, THAT TEAM WILL BE COMPLETELY DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT. IF A TEAM DOES NOT SHOW UP FOR ITS SECOND GAME, IT IS TOTALLY DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT.



23. If a team has committed a fraud, either to favor itself or to favor another team, and there are the means of proof, the organization of INTERNATIONAL INDOOR 2025 will take the corresponding measures.

24. Schedules For unforeseen reasons, the tournament reserves the right to modify the schedule of games at any time.

25. When a team leaves the tournament before it starts, the tournament directors have the right to replace that team at least 12 hours before the tournament starts.

26. Anything not provided for in these regulations and competition system will be resolved by the INTERNATIONAL INDOOR 2025 tournament committee.

27. The administration of the INTERNATIOANL INDOOR 2025 is not responsible for damages inside and outside the facilities, the players play under their own responsibility

28. It is forbidden to bring alcoholic beverages, only water, hydrating drinks and food will be allowed for the teams.

29. It is forbidden to use any type of firearm or sharp weapon.

- 30. The game starts when the referee blows the whistle
- 31. There will be no 3-line rule
- 32. Each team will be responsible for picking up their own trash.
- 33. All shots are direct with the exception of when the ball hits the net.
- 34. If a team receives a red card, the team must play short of one player for a period of 5



Minutes, no player will be able to enter in case there is a goal against. If a team receives a yellow card, the team must play with one player less for a

2 minute period. If the team with the lowest goal difference concedes a goal, the team may enter a player.

35. If a player receives a red card, this player will no longer be able to play for the remainder of that match.

- 36. Each team will play with 7 players (6 players plus a goalkeeper).
- 37. All players will have to play with shin guards.
- 38. Playing with studs will not be allowed.
- 39. All players will have to play in uniforms of the same color.
- 40. Earrings, necklaces, bracelets, or other accessories may not be worn
- 41. Goalkeepers will have to wear a different color than their teammates
- 42. If a coach is ejected, he must leave the court immediately.
- 43. Sweeps will NOT be allowed.
- 44. A goalkeeper cannot score with his hands.
- 45. The clock will stop on injuries.

46. If there is a foul before the game is over and then the game ends, then the foul has to be executed

47. If a player returns the ball to his own goalkeeper, the goalkeeper may not touch it with his hands

- 48. On the sixth foul, the opposing team will be awarded a shootout.
- 49. All plays must be put into play within 5 seconds at the latest.

1) The Tournament will be held with the participation of 9 teams divided into 3 groups. Each group will be

formed with 3 teams so that from the 3 groups they give us 9 teams.

2) The formation of the groups will be made under a draw made with the presence of the

3) We will not have group leaders.

4) Each team will play 2 matches. The 8 teams enter a general table to form the bracket.

5) The ranking of the 8 teams will depend on the points and goals they have achieved in the preliminary phase of their

groups.

1) The Tournament will be held with the participation of 32 teams divided into 8 groups. Each group will be

2) The formation of the groups will be made under a draw made with the presence of the

representatives or majority of the participating teams.

3) We will not have group leaders.

4) Each team will play 3 matches. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will advance to the playoffs on Sunday.

5) The ranking of the 24 teams will depend on the points and goals they have achieved in the qualifying phase of their



groups. The 1st place in each group will rest the first round of the Playoffs
