Registration for Fall 2024-2025

We are currently accepting registration for the 2024-2025 school year. If your child will be returning/continuing at Grace in August 2025 the annual registration fee of \$50.00 per child or \$75.00 per child that will also attend Readiness is due. All registration fees are due by March 7th. I will add an invoice for registration fees on your March statements.

Children that are 4 by August 1st will be dual enrolled (included in your Day Care tuition) in Day Care/Readiness and attend the Monday, Wednesday, Friday **afternoon class**. If your child is full-time, there is not an additional monthly fee for Preschool. If your child is part-time, the monthly fee of \$135.00 will be due the 1st of each month in addition to your weekly childcare payment.

Children that are 3 by August 1st can enroll in Readiness for the Tuesday, Thursday morning class for a **separate** monthly fee of \$120.00. Register as soon as possible as classes fill quickly.

Please return your completed Readiness registration form as soon as possible as classes are filling up quickly.

Parent Reminders

- *Our drop-off ends at 9:30. If your child is not here by then, we will assume they are not coming unless you have messaged us prior with details such as a late arrival due to a doctor's appointment, etc.
- *Sign your child in/out <u>daily</u>. We still have families not signing in/out. It is a <u>REQUIREMENT</u>. There are QR codes posted in many areas for your convenience.
- *Please make sure you are parking in a designated parking spot at drop-off or pick -up. Do not park in front of the building as this creates a safety issue for our other families.
- *Do use the portico or Door #6 between 8:40-9:15 as it interferes with the preschool carline.
- *Grace closes promptly at 5:30. All late families are auto-charged a late fee of \$5.00 per minute/per child.

- *Please remember to wash your child's hands prior to entering the classroom as we have children with severe allergies and with cold and flu season, we want to limit the germs we share.

Illness, Communicable Diseases & COVID-19

If children become ill during the day, are vomiting, have two loose stools or a temperature of 100 degrees or higher, we will notify parents to pick them up. Children should not return to school for at least 24 hours after the last symptom and without fever reducing medication. **Keep children home if they have signs of the following:**

- a fever, vomiting or diarrhea in the past 24 hours.
- given fever reducing medication in the past 24 hrs.
- a heavy nasal discharge, or green/yellow in color.
- a constant cough or labored breathing.
- seem overtired, fussy, cranky, not their usual selves.
- symptoms of a possible communicable disease, such as sniffles, red eyes, sore throat, headache, or abdominal pain, especially if accompanied by fever and/or spots.
