Proposed Schedule for Weekend Church Ministry in Texas

WEDNESDAY – Travel Day (Depending on travel distance, can be adjusted to Thursday)

- Arrive in late afternoon or early evening

THURSDAY – Day of Prayer & Fasting

- Initial Meeting with Lead Pastor

FRIDAY – Day of Prayer & Fasting; Evening Prayer Meeting at Church

- A.M. – Meeting with Lead Pastor and/or Staff as necessary
- P.M. – Friday night church prayer meeting with strong emphasis on seeking His face (2 Chronicles 7:14); entire church invited, no music service, no teaching/preaching; no recording or online broadcast; no coffee or food served

SATURDAY – Morning Men's Meeting; Final Preparations for Sunday

- A.M. – Men's "After-Breakfast" prayer, teaching, and time of ministry – Walter Lackey, Jr. (Typical message will address the topics of what it means to follow Christ; priesthood in the home for married and single men; purity; and the righteousness of Christ in men); no recording or online broadcast; breakfast on your own prior to meeting; no coffee or food served
- P.M. – Prayer and final preparations for Sunday

SUNDAY – Sunday Services (Morning – entire church; Evening – youth and college)

- A.M. – Sunday main service(s) – Walter Lackey, Jr. (Message will be based on needs of church discussed in meeting with lead pastor and leadership of the Holy Spirit)
 - Prayer and altar ministry after service – Walter Lackey, Jr. and Madison Lackey
- P.M. – Youth and college joint meeting – Madison Lackey and Walter Lackey, Jr. (Typical message will include a presentation of the Gospel in the context of denying yourself, picking up your cross and following Jesus, along with instruction on how to follow Christ in the context of relationship problems, divorce in the home, religion, personal sin, societal issues, spiritual problems, and challenges at school); no recording or online broadcast; prefer no food served unless after service

MONDAY – Travel Day

- A.M. – Exit meeting with Lead Pastor; Return home
