Statement of Purpose

CORPORATE EXPRESSION OF CHRIST – JESUS IS THE HEAD OF THE CHURCH.

At the church in our home and when we travel to other church gatherings and facilities, including the local church in our town, we want Christ the hope of glory to be in us and through us, and the model of Acts to define us. *Matthew 18:16; 1 Corinthians 16:19 & Philemon 1:1-3; 1 Corinthians 16:15-16; Romans 16:1-2; Colossians 1:27; Acts 2:42 & 46*. Ultimately, we value the succession of the Christian faith in generational, familial cycles over the growth of denominations, organizations, and non-denominations. The individual and the family is where Christ must be allowed to govern, then more spiritual life and health will arrive in our local congregations.

MINISTRY EXPRESSION OF CHRIST – JESUS IS THE EXAMPLE MINISTER.

Our heart is to serve in Christ's body, the church. *John 13:14; Colossians 2:19; Colossians 1:18*. Our preparation is prayer, fasting and Bible study.
