This Month in History Selected March Dates of Marine Corps Historical Significance

- **27 April 1805:** Lt. Presley O'Bannon and seven Marines lead attack against Derna, Tripoli.
- **21 April 1914:** Marine regiments land at Veracurz, Mexico, to keep German guns from Mexican dictator.
- **9 April 1942:** 105 Marines among Americans on Bataan Death March.
- **1 April 1945:** On Easter Sunday, US Tenth Army, including 1st and 6th Marine divisions, land on Okinawa.
- **28 April 1965:** 6th Marines land in Dominican Republic..
- **12 April 1975:** Marines evacuate foreigners before Khmer Rouge seize Phnom Penh, Cambodia.
- **30 April 1975:** 4th Marines under Col. Alfred M. Gray complete evacuation by helicopters from Saigon embassy and Tan Son Nhut airfield.
- **24 April 1980:** Three Marines killed in desert accident during effort to rescue Teheran hostages.
- **19 April 1994:** Marines evacuate foreigners from Rwanda.

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Legislative



The legislative session in Annapolis has ended with no activity relative to bills HG176/SB-445 (Income Tax-Subtraction-Military Retirement Income) to increase

the subtraction from \$5,000 to \$20,000. Because of the looming major deficit in the state budget, it is unlikely that any increase in the current "subtraction" will be considered by next year's session.

FYI: The Maryland 2007 Regular Session considered 49 veteran and military related legislation. 23 of the bills were passed.

During the current U.S. legislative session, there is a struggle between the republicans and democrats to increase the budget for veteran's programs. We're talking about "billions" of dollars over various time frames. One important fact about all this give-and-take by the politicians is the budget, once agreed upon, could be the largest one-year jump in money for veterans in 77 years, according to one pol.

In an awards matter, the Marine Corps Forces – Central Command has clarified the combat actions that merit the Bronze Star versus the Meritorious Service Medal (MSM). The key element of the clarification is to show the combatant experienced "increased risk" in order to rate the Bronze Star above the MSM. There has been confusion in the ranks regarding the awarding of these two medals.




Tax Benefits

Property Tax Exemption: A property tax exemption is available to veterans who are permanently and totally disabled from service-connected causes, for their primary residence located in the State of Maryland. The exemption passes to the veteran's spouse upon his or her death. The surviving spouse of active duty military personnel who died in the line of duty as well as the surviving spouse of a totally disabled veteran, or a spouse who receives the dependency and indemnity compensation (effective June 30, 2006) may also receive an exemption.


