**NEW BUSINESS:**

- Norman Huffman reported on the recruitment drive at Downs Park Community Family Day. Manny, Ben, Ray, Joe and Norm attended and met a large number of people. - Ray Sturm made a motion that three members be appointed by the Commandant to administer the program. They shall report back to the Commandant with a written by-law change within 90 days.
- Ben Wells made a motion (requested by Jim Brady in his absence) for the Detachment to donate \$250 to the Ladies Auxiliary to help offset the cost of the coins they had made up for the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. It was voted on and accepted.
- Joe Wright made a motion to give the VFW one-thousand dollars (\$1000) for the building fund to help with the repairs to the building. It was voted on and accepted.
