HISTORIAN WEB SERGEANT: Absent



NEW BUSINESS: Bill Collins asked for a \$100 donation for Healing Waters. (Healing Waters is an organization dedicated to the physical and emotional rehabilitation of disabled active military service personnel and disabled veterans through fly fishing and associated activities including education and outings.) Voted on and passed.

Commandant Ray Sturm had pictures of our new proposed logo designed by Bill Collins. Motion made to adopt this logo as our official logo. Voted on and passed unanimously. We are going to draft some shirts with the logo. Bill Collins stated the Marine Corps cannot apply a decal on any shirt not made in the USA. Jim Brady reminded the group that the detachment can only sell their decal items to their own detachment and not to the general public. You can give it away, but not sell.

Commandant Sturm asked for a motion to spend no more than \$50 to buy black material for a memorial drape. Motion made and passed.

Commandant Sturm recently made contact with the Baltimore Recruiting District. (Gunny Sergeant was supposed to be in attendance, but was working.) They are wishing to help Marine families with food baskets (ham / turkey) dinners and toys for their Christmas party. The families will be registered with Toys for Tots. Baltimore and Harford County detachments are also going to help with this. Edie Remines husband Rick will be Santa Claus. Jim Brady made a motion we donate \$500. It was second. Discussion on who the recipients were. Don Benson stated he thought it was for E-3 and below families, Young Marines, and Reservist. Original motion was voted on and passed. Commandant Sturm will contact the Captain at the Recruiting District to see exactly what is expected.

Commandant Sturm brought up the need for a storage container to place beside the building. It is a 40' X 7 ½' box that the detachment would use for storing long term items, and sharing with Toys for Tots. A written proposal needs to be presented to the VFW. Jim Brady made comment on the VFW storage units, that they are not sealed or weather tight and they had to clean them out quite a few times for mildew from dampness. This was tabled until a later time.

Ben Wells asked about the donation to Troop 216 and was informed that it was in the budget. The check for 2017. Jim Galvin reported the troop went on their camping trip which cost @ \$500. All donations are appreciated.

Commandant Sturm stated the Marine Corp Cryptologic Ball was a great evening and anyone who missed it, missed a great time.
