## **Corps History**

#### 1 February

1967 Operation Prairie II began in Quang Tri province by elements of the 3rd Marine Division. During the 46 day search-and-destroy operation, 93 Marines and 693 enemy combatants were killed.

#### 20 February

1815 Captain Archibald Henderson leads Marines in the USS Constitution's capture of HMS Cyane and HMS Levant, which occurs 3 days after the end of the War of 1812.

#### 20 February

1962 Lieutenant Colonel John H. Glenn Jr. orbits the earth in first manned American space capsule.

#### 23 February

1945 Men of the 5th Marine Division raise flag on Mount Suribachi.

#### 24 February

1991 1st and 2nd Marine Divisions breach Iraqi defensive positions.

#### 24 February

1991: The I Marine Expeditionary Force and coalition forces began a ground assault on Iraqi defenses in the final chapter of Operation Desert Storm.

#### 26 February

1991 A Marine recon unit was the first U.S. force to enter Kuwait City and retake the American Embassy.

#### 28 February

1991: Operation Desert Storm ends. I Marine Expeditionary Force, with a strength of more than 92,000 for the operation, becomes largest Marine Corps operation in history. 24 Marines were killed in action during the Gulf War.

#### 28 February

1967 PFC James Anderson Jr. is first black Marine to win the Medal of Honor.
