Our nation's Vietnam War Commemoration is an opportunity for all Americans to recognize, honor, and thank our Vietnam Veterans and their families for their service and sacrifice during one of the longest wars in our country's history.

The commemoration recognizes all men and women who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces during the United States' involvement in Vietnam November 1, 1955 May 7, 1975. Nine million Americans, approximately 7.2 million living today, served during that period. The commemoration makes no distinction between Veterans who served in-country, in-theater, or were stationed elsewhere during those 20 years. All answered the call to duty.

Greetings Marines,

I have a lot to cover this month. We still seem to be in the grips of Ol' Man Winter, but spring is around the corner, I promise. With spring comes our annual golf tournament on May 18th. We need your help.

I attended the National Mid-Winter Conference held in Fredericksburg, VA from 1-3 March. The following are highlights from the various speakers. Many of the actual presentations and officer's reports can be found on the new MCL library website created by our COO, Bill Borka. Please visit www.mcleaquelibrary.org for details.

The MCL donated to John Toomey's walking of the Pacific Crest Trail, which essentially runs from the Canadian border to the Mexican border. He raised over \$56,000 for veterans with PTSD.

Johnny Baker, the National JVC reported that efforts are underway to include the MCL in the Transition Assistance Program each Marine goes through prior to EAS. He said that approximately 33,000 Marines transition from active duty to the 1stCivDiv every year. These are potential members.

He also reported that the **new National Bylaws** are nearly complete. He managed to reduce the bylaws from over 200 pages down to 22. This was done by relocating items to the Administrative Procedures, which he is also working on. Stay tuned. More details will be coming out before the National Convention in August.

The MCL will be reestablishing a connection with the **Marine For Life** program. It was stated that the detachments can assist by offering the M4L organization a place to meet periodically. This could lead to an excellent networking opportunity for our members.

Jarhead Java has a good deal. MCL members can use the code "MCL" at checkout and receive free shipping. In addition, they will donate \$3 from every purchase to the League. See the national website for details. www.mclnational.org.

The long awaited new database is nearing completion. The intent is to start Beta testing with one MCL Division in about 60 days. Fingers crossed.

For those members who have family or friends applying for **MCL scholarships**, the deadline for submission is 16 July. Details are on line on the national website. Last year, \$700 was awarded to those selected.

The National Commandant made a presentation on IRS and State filings. Needless to say, we must remain diligent and meet all legal requirements. His presentation is on the new library site.

The Centennial Anniversary of the **1st Women Marines** is being celebrated in Washington, DC from 30 August to 3 September.

Toys For Tots was a huge success once again. Nationally, the program collected 18 million toys which were distributed to 7 million children. The T4T program is a highly ranked non-profit. 97% of funds raised go to the program, 3% goes towards overhead related to fundraising, and 0% goes to salaries. There were over 800 local T4T campaigns with 278 run by MCL detachments. The MCL's contribution to the effort was impressive with 3.9 million toys collected and 1.2 million children affected. Well Done Marines!

We have been asked to start tracking funeral honor guard details. We can expect to see more coming down from National regarding funeral details, including some guidance in the form of an SOP.

LtGen Rex McMillan gave a presentation regarding the state of the USMCR. He said our reserve component is in great shape.. and the I&I staffs are working overtime to prepare for the next conflict. In addition to their battle preparations, they are tasked with providing funeral details for our fallen brothers and sisters. Last year, the I&I staffs conducted 22,000 funerals. That number is expected to rise to 25,000 over the next several years. The General came to ask for our help. He said, and I quote, "I'm here on bent knees. I need your assistance." He said he has no intention of giving up funeral details, but needs a little backup from the League. Even if we could provide a bugler, it would help tremendously. He has instructed his I&I staffs to reach out to the MCL detachments in the area. He said if we don't hear from them, to walk in and say he sent us.

Folks, now I'm asking for your help. If you would like to assist, please let me know. We have volunteer opportunities available in a wide range of programs from perhaps establishing a funeral detail, our nursing home visitation program, the golf tournament, etc. Semper Fi, \\// Ray

3 March 1776

11 March 1778

Marines aboard the frigate BOSTON, assisted in the engagement and capture of the British merchant ship MARTHA. Future President John Adams seized a musket and joined the Marines on deck until the frigate's commanding officer, Captain Samuel Tucker, sent him below for safety.

13 March 1943

First Women Marine officer candidates arrive at U.S. Midshipmen School at Mount Holyoke College.

21 March 1945

General A.A. Vandegrift, 18th Commandant, becomes first Marine four-star general on active duty.

25 March 1804

Secretary of the Navy approves first formal Marine Corps uniform.

26 March 1945

Iwo Jima secured. Marines suffer 25,851 casualties.

31 March 1801

Lt. Colonel Commandant William W. Burrows & President Thomas Jefferson select site for Marine Barracks, 8th & I.



Early this month your Commandant, Sr.Vice & Chaplain attended the Mid-Winter National Staff Conference in Fredericksburg, VA. The conference provided a great opportunity to meet with Senior Marine Corps League officials. We spent time with Wendell W. Webb, Commandant and CEO of the Marine Corps League. We brought him up to speed on our efforts to support and promote Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment (HBOT) for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBI's). The Commandant is familiar with HBOT and expressed his willingness to support our efforts. Many of us are not familiar with these brain related wounds and have guestions as to why we are having so many suicides among our Veterans. We don't remember a problem of this magnitude associated with past wars. What is different? The answer is provided in a book that was distributed at the conference. The title of the book is "INVISIBLE SCARS" by Bart P. Billings, Ph.D. www.DocUmeantPublishing.com In this outstanding book, Dr. Billings describes the VA & the military's decision to use brain/mind altering medications for combat stress and the effects these drugs are having on our veterans. This book is a must read for anyone who knows or treats those with combat related problems, such as, PTS, PTSD, or TBI. If you have difficulty getting a copy please let me know.


