


Semper Jidelis!

Lt. Gen. David Berger nominated as next commandant of the Marine Corps



His nomination was submitted Tuesday, according to a Senate notice, and it requests that he be promoted to the rank of general. If his nomination is approved, Berger will be the 38th commandant of the Marine Corps.

Since his commissioning in 1981, Berger has served in multiple prestigious assignments including director of operations for the Department of Plans, Policies, and Operations, Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps; commanding general, 1st Marine Division (Forward) in support of Operation Enduring

Freedom; commanding general,

Berger has been the commanding general of Marine Corps Combat Development Command and the Deputy Commandant for Combat Development and Integration since August. Prior to his current assignment, I Marine Expeditionary Force; and commander, U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Pacific.

Corps History

1 April 1945

1st & 6th Marine Divisions land on Okinawa.

2-3 April 2003

5th Marine Regimental Combat Team captures bridges over Tigris River to open the path to Baghdad.

3 April 1945

Marines of the III Amphibious Corps effectively cut Okinawa in half in three days rather than the originally projected eleven.

8 April 1956

Six recruits drown in Ribbon Creek at MCRD Parris Island.

9 April 1942

105 Marines among American captives on Bataan Death March.

13 April 2003

Marines locate seven American soldiers held prisoner by the Iraqis near Samarra.

14 April 1865

Marines guard the body of John Wilkes Booth after the assassination of Abraham Lincoln.

15 April 1962

Marine Corps operational involvement in the Vietnam War begins, when HMM-362 arrives at Soc Trang in the Delta south of Saigon – as part of Operation Shufly – to air-lift Vietnamese troops into battle.

18 April 1983

A Marine Security Guard is killed and seven wounded when a large car bomb explodes just outside the U.S. Embassy in Beirut, Lebanon.

19 April 1995

Captain Randolph A. Guzman and Sergeant Benjamin L. Davis are killed when the Alfred Murrah Federal Office Building is bombed in Oklahoma City, OK.

Chaplain's Corner Bill Collins



Airey, Emanuel L. " Manny"

31 March 2019 was a day of great loss to the Detachment, the League, the Marine Corps and to the United States of America. Our fellow Marine Manny was ordered to report to the Supreme Comman-

dant. I suspect that there was need for a Sergeant of the guard for the Detachment that guards the heavenly streets. I believe that Manny would laugh out loud if he heard me saying those words and that he would probably call me "Numb Nuts" for having written them. Manny was a member of the "greatest generation" having served in some of the most iconic battles in Marine Corps history. He served at Iwo Jima, Tarawa and Saipan as a Navy Frog Man clearing underwater obstacles and mapping Japanese defensive positions. He was in Tokyo Bay when surrender documents were signed by the Japanese aboard the Battleship Missouri. It can be argued that Manny was a slow learner because shortly after WWII he enlisted in the Marine Corps. In June of 1950 the North Koreans invaded South Korea and Manny found himself with the 1st Marine Division at Pusan, Inchon and the Chosin Reservoir. Manny was with the 11th Marines, "The Cannon Cockers" as they fought their way through the thousands of Communist Chinese troops who had the 1st Marine Division surrounded. He received a purple heart after being shot and a second one for the frost bite that nearly cost him both of his feet. Manny was enthusiastic about raising money for "the kids" and always contributed more than his share. He was a good man, a good friend and a great Marine. He was one of a kind, he cannot be replaced. We miss him. Semper Fi Manny.
